## Little Sister of the Poor Sister Alexis Berchmans Served Aged Poor for 74 years

Little Sister of the Poor Sister Alexis Berchmans died on April 16 at the order's St. Augustine Home for the Aged in Indianapolis. She was 94. The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on April 20 at the chapel at the St. Augustine Home. Burial followed at Holy Cross Cemetery in Indianapolis.

Sister Alexis was born on July 9, 1923, in Lafayette, Ind. She entered the Little Sisters of the Poor after graduating from high school, professed first vows on Dec. 10, 1943, and final vows on Oct. 15, 1948. After many years of ministering to the aged poor in Baltimore and Evansville, Ind., Sister Alexis came to live at the St. Augustine Home in 2014. She is survived by a sister, Paula Alexander, of Lafayette.

## The *Spirit of Love for the Little Sisters of the Poor* Made Visible at our Annual *Hats* <u>Off to Spring Fundraiser</u>

The *Spirit of Love for the Little Sisters of the Poor* was made visible by the number of attendees at our 2018 HOTS and by the money raised. In the April 2018 Gazette we shared that the goal was to net \$60,000. Below are the statistics for this year's HOTS, and the numbers speak to our success as a Guild.

We exceeded our goal by **\$19,809** (and a little change)!!! With the \$79,809.62, and a little extra from the Guild's end of year funds, the Guild is able to present a check to Mother Francis Gabriel for **\$83,000**. Add that amount to the **\$12,909.16** raised from the Christmas Bazaar fundraiser and that comes to a total of **\$95,909.16** raised by the Guild for the Little Sisters during this past 2017-2018 business year.
