One of the duties of the corresponding secretary is to send condolence cards and get-well cards. Here are guidelines for when to notify Mary Patout:
(1) Guild members who pass away during the course of the year, and family members of guild members (spouses, children, parents, grandchildren) who pass away during that time;
(2) Hospitalizations, major illnesses and significant medical procedures (such as chemotherapy, or cardiac rehab); the corresponding secretary can send a 'get well' note, and also alert our members via email, if prayers are needed, and requested by a Guild member

When you become aware of information in either of these two categories, via information from your parish, or through personal contact, please help Mary out, and pass the information on to her. Her email and phone number are both in our Roster.

Thank you for helping Mary with our Guild correspondence for the year. For those of you who are long-time members of the Guild, your help is invaluable to both Mary, and our Chair of the Mass for the Deceased that we celebrate every March (especially because most of the Executive Officers are fairly new to the Guild, and would not necessarily recognize Guild members when reading the Indy Star obituaries).
